



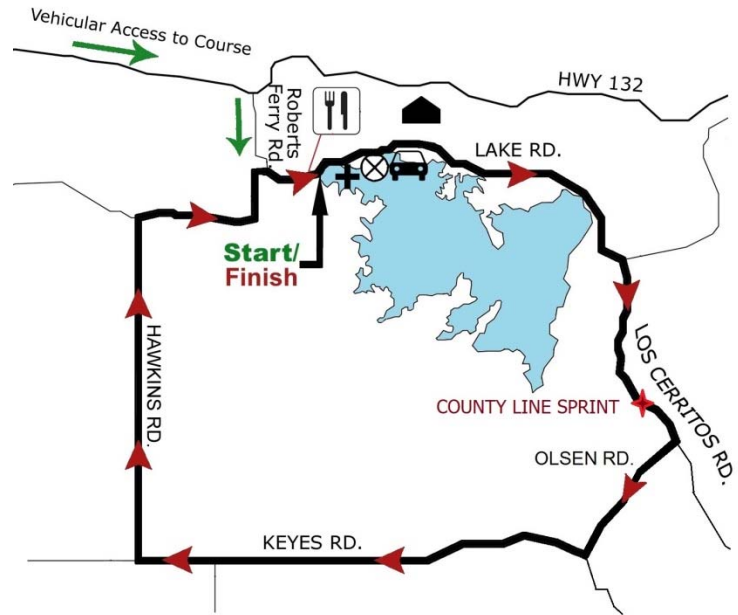
The 4th Annual

Turlock Lake Road Race

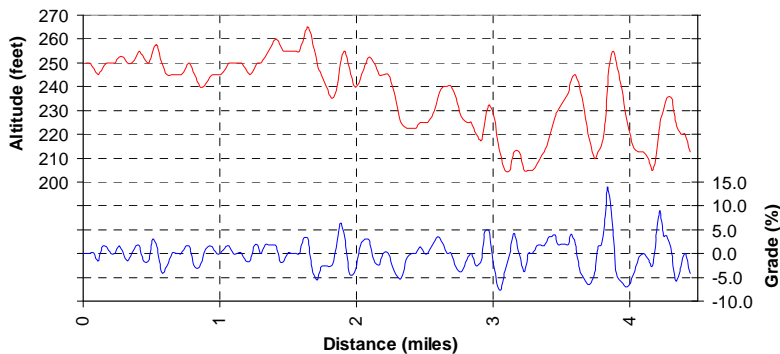

Resurrected from the former Junior District Road Race Championships, this roller-fest winds through the scenic almond orchards around Turlock Lake and overlaps a section of the Snelling Road Race. A key feature of this course is the famed **Hawkins Road**, which delights climbers and Clydesdales alike with its progressively taller and seemingly endless series of rollers. Expect plenty of attacks here, especially on the last lap as the finish line is only a few miles away. For some extra fun, a prime sprint is featured during the first lap of each race. And be sure to bring your spare wheels. Neutral rider support vehicles will be following all fields!

TLRR is a particularly spectator- and supporter-friendly event. The main parking and registration area is at the state park with picnic tables, barbeque pits, public restrooms and sandy beaches.
